O'Neil & Associates Part of Winning ATLAS II Team for the U.S. Army

Miamisburg, OH. - February 5, 2007—O'Neil & Associates, Inc. announced they are being awarded a subcontract from JLG Industries, Inc., the world's leading producer of access equipment, and a subsidiary of Oshkosh Truck Corporation. JLG was awarded a contract valued at \$102.2 million by the U.S. Army for the purchase of 566 JLG(R) ATLAS II military telescopic material handlers over the next 5 years. The machines will be delivered for deployment throughout the U.S. Army in all logistics areas. The contract includes requirements for field service support, add-on armor, performance-based logistics, and simulators for training purposes.

The O'Neil subcontract includes using the latest technology to develop technical documentation, training materials, provisioning, and related logistics data to support JLG's ATLAS II forklift. The majority of the work will be performed in calendar year 2007 at their Miamisburg (Dayton) headquarters with support from their office in San Diego.



Their deliverables will include:

- **Logistics Management Information (LMI):** Maintenance Analysis, National Maintenance Work Requirement (NMWR) Data Summary (including the NMWR Candidate List), and Special Tools and Test Equipment (STTE) List.
- **Provisioning:** Provisioning Parts List (PPL), Engineering Data for Provisioning (EDFP), and Screening Results.
- **Training Materials:** Operator and maintainer training materials with Student and Instructor Training Guides; also training materials and Computer-Based Training (CBT) to provide integrated instruction on the ATLAS II.
- **Technical Manuals:** A Class V Interactive Electronic Technical Manual (IETM) with intrusive diagnostics using the Next Generation of EMS (Electronic Maintenance System). O'Neil is the first company to use EMS-NG and is using it on two other TACOM programs, HEMTT and PLS. O'Neil also has the TACOM prime contract for EMS-NG software development. The ATLAS II IETM will consist of the Operator's Manual, Maintenance Manual, and a Repair Parts and Special Tools List (RPSTL) manual, and the Warranty Technical Bulletin (TB). The IETM will fully leverage the vehicle onboard diagnostics and include Point-to-Point (P2P) circuit diagrams.

The rugged and dependable ATLAS II transports all types of materials through water, sand, mud, and other rugged terrain our troops encounter. The ATLAS II brings the same robust, combat-proven design as the ATLAS I with additional features, such as lube-for-life systems

and onboard diagnostics. This combination reduces machine annual maintenance by 75 percent and provides point-of-use access to diagnostic information. The ATLAS II's tier-III engine significantly reduces noise and exhaust emissions, making it compliant with EPA and CE regulations. The availability of multiple attachments, such as various fork configurations, a utility bucket, and forkrollers, provide added versatility.
